On December 14, 2007, the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington issued Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Enter Order to Issue Cease and Desist (“Statement of Charges”), S-07-372-07-SC01, against Filter Technology of America, Inc., Cooking Oil Filtering Systems of America, Inc., and Donald E. Jacoy. Pursuant to the Securities Act of Washington, RCW 21.20, the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions (“Securities Division”) and Respondent Donald E. Jacoy do hereby enter into this CONSENT ORDER in settlement of the above captioned matter with respect to Respondent Donald E. Jacoy. The Securities Division has, in the Statement of Charges, made certain allegations and conclusions, set forth under the headings “Tentative Findings of Fact” and “Conclusions of Law.” Respondent Donald E. Jacoy neither admits nor denies the Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

CONSENT ORDER

Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest:

1 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy, shall cease and
2 desist from violating RCW 21.20.010, the anti-fraud section of the Securities Act of
3 Washington.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy shall
5 cease and desist from offering or selling securities in violation of RCW 21.20.140, the
6 securities registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

7
8 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy shall
9 cease and desist from acting as an unregistered securities broker-dealer or salesperson in
10 violation of RCW 21.20.040, the broker-dealer and securities salesperson registration section
11 of the Securities Act of Washington.

12 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy shall pay the Securities
13 Division the costs and other expenses incurred in the investigation of this matter in the amount of
14 \$2,000. The payments shall be made as follows. Respondent Donald E. Jacoy shall make an
15 initial payment of \$200 on or before January 15, 2010 prior to the entry of this Order.
16 Respondent Donald E. Jacoy shall continue to make monthly payments of \$200 on or before the
17 fifteenth day of the following four months and make a final payment of \$1,000 on or before June
18 15, 2010.

20 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in the event that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy defaults
21 on any payment, the Division will provide notice of default and may thereafter seek recovery of
22 the amounts due, plus costs and attorney fees, pursuant to remedies available under the Securities
23 Act of Washington, RCW 21.20.

24 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondent Donald E. Jacoy enters into this Consent
25 Order freely and voluntarily and with a full understanding of its terms and significance.

1 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this Order.

2 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in consideration of the foregoing, Respondent Donald E.
3 Jacoy waives his right to a hearing in this matter and judicial review of this order.


