## STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Please take notice that the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington has reason to believe that Respondents, Stevens Coffee Company LLC dba Java Girls tm and Steven McDaniel, have each violated the Franchise Investment Protection Act of Washington, RCW 19.100, and that their violations justify the entry of an order of the Securities Administrator under RCW 19.100.248 to cease and desist from such violations. The Securities Administrator finds as follows:

## TENTATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

## Respondents

- 1. Stevens Coffee Company LLC dba Java Girls <sup>tm</sup> ("Java Girls") is a Washington limited liability company currently conducting business at 3805 Auburn Way N., Auburn, Washington. Java Girls was established in 2003.
- 2. Steven McDaniel ("McDaniel") is the owner and President of Java Girls. McDaniel is a resident of Washington.

## Nature of the Offering

- 3. Java Girls, a business that integrates customer entertainment with specialty coffee services, first opened in the greater Seattle area. Java Girls features gourmet espresso served by baristas dressed in revealing outfits corresponding to different theme days.
- 4. McDaniel is offering for sale a Java Girls "Trademark License Opportunity." This opportunity is being offered and sold in the United States, Canada and Europe, with only a limited number for sale. Due to the offer and sale of this opportunity, there are currently several Java Girls locations in the United States.
- 5. Purchasers of the "Trademark License Opportunity" pay a \$25,000 fee per territory. Purchasers have the right to open an unlimited number of Java Girls coffee businesses within the designated territory. Purchasers receive training, ongoing managerial support, a marketing package, and assistance with every phase of operation including start-up.
- 6. The Trademark License Agreement grants purchasers of the opportunity the right to use the Java Girls trademarks, service marks, and other intellectual property.
- 7. An annual renewal fee of \$1,200 is required from purchasers. In addition to renewing the agreement, in return for this fee purchasers receive ten hours of consultation and a webpage maintained on the corporate website.
- 8. According to the Java Girls website, there is an "unlimited income potential," purchasers can "earn more than double the gross income of other similar retail specialty coffee establishments," and the "average gross income generated for a Java Girls tm Licensee is approx \$300k per year service window/counter and you should net between 30% to 35% of the gross but this will also depend on the skill of the operator."

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

15. The offer or sale of the opportunity described above constitutes the offer or sale of a franchise as defined in RCW 19.100.010(16) and RCW 19.100.010(4).

16. The offer or sale of said franchises is in violation of RCW 19.100.020 because no registration for such offer or sale is on file with the Securities Administrator.

17. The offer or sale of said franchises is in violation of RCW 19.100.170 because Respondents either made untrue statements of material fact or omitted to state a material fact necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading.

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE AN ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

Based upon the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Securities Administrator intends to order that Respondents, Stevens Coffee Company LLC dba Java Girls <sup>tm</sup> and Steven McDaniel, and their agents and employees, shall each cease and desist from violations of RCW 19.100.020 and RCW 19.100.170.

# **AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE**

This Statement of Charges is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 19.100.248 and RCW 19.100.130 and is subject to the provisions of RCW 34.05. Respondents, Stevens Coffee Company LLC dba Java Girls <sup>tm</sup> and Steven McDaniel may each make a written request for a hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING accompanying this order.
