The Securities Division and 14 Respondents, Corps Investment Group, LLC and Hezekiah Corppetts, do hereby agree to this 15 Consent Order in settlement of the above captioned order. The Securities Division has, in the 16 Statement of Charges, made certain allegations and conclusions, set forth under the headings 17 "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law". Corps Investment Group, LLC and 18 Hezekiah Corppetts neither admit nor deny the Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of 19 Law, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order. 20 **CONSENT ORDER** 21 Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest: 22 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Corps Investment Group, LLC and 23 Hezekiah Corppetts, shall each cease and desist from offering or selling business opportunities in 24
