STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Please take notice that the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington has reason to believe that Respondents, Corps Investment Group; LLC, Hezekiah Corppetts; Patricia Weis and Milton Johnson, have each violated the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of Washington and that their violations justify the entry of an order of the Securities Administrator under RCW 19.110.150 against each to cease and desist from such violations. The Securities Administrator finds as follows:

TENTATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

I. RESPONDENTS

1. Corps Investment Group, LLC (“Corps Investment”) is a member-managed Washington Limited Liability Company with its principal place of business in Spokane, Washington.

1 and/or omitted to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of
2 circumstances under which they were made, not misleading and/or engaged in acts and practices
3 that operated as fraud or deceit.

4 **NOTICE OF INTENT TO ORDER THE RESPONDENT TO CEASE AND DESIST**

5 Based on the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Securities
6 Administrator intends to order that Respondents, Corps Investment Group, LLC, Hezekiah
7 Corppetts, Patricia Weis and Milton Johnson, and their agents and employees, each shall cease
8 and desist from violations of RCW 19.110.050 and RCW 19.110.120.

9 **AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE**

10 This Statement of Charges is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 19.110.150 and
11 is subject to the provisions of RCW 34.05. The Respondents, Corps Investment Group, LLC,
12 Hezekiah Corppetts, Patricia Weis and Milton Johnson, may each make a written request for a
13 hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND OPPORTUNITY
14 FOR HEARING accompanying this order.


15 If a respondent does not request a hearing, the Securities Administrator intends to adopt
16 the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as final and enter a final order to
17 cease and desist as to that respondent.
