SUMMARY ORDER SUSPENDING INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION

STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Please take notice that the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington has reason to believe that Respondent, Stat Investment Strategies, Corp., has violated the Securities Act of Washington and that the entry of an order of the Securities Administrator under RCW 21.20.110 to suspend the effectiveness of its current registration as an investment adviser is justified. The Securities Administrator finds that delay in ordering the suspension of the Respondent's current registration would be hazardous to the investors and to the public and that the Order should be entered immediately. The Securities Administrator finds as follows:

TENTATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

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SUMMARY ORDER REVOKING INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION

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Stat Investment Strategies, Corp. ("Stat") is a dissolved corporation that was organized under the laws of California with its principal place of business at 865 South Figueroa Street, Suite 1388, Los Angeles, California 90017. Stephan John Miskjian is the President of Stat and its registered agent with a listed address of 1226 N. Brand Blvd.; Glendale, California 91202. The fiscal year end for Stat is December 31.

II.

Stat is currently registered as an investment adviser with the Securities Division pursuant to RCW 21.20.040 under file number 30002624. That registration expires on December 31, 2008. The file number of Stat in the Investment Adviser Registration Depository ("IARD") is 0133212.

III.

Stephan John Miskjian is currently licensed as an investment adviser representative for Stat pursuant to RCW 21.20.040 under Central Registration Depository ("CRD") file number 2844720.

IV.

In accordance with WAC 460-24A-060, each investment adviser registered with the Securities Division is required to file a balance sheet prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles as of the end of its fiscal year not more than ninety days after the end of its fiscal year.

V.

In accordance with WAC 460-24A-205, each investment adviser registered with the Securities Division is required to file an updated Form ADV with the IARD within ninety days of the end of its fiscal year.

VI.

During a recent review, the Securities Division discovered that the most recent balance sheet submitted by Stat to the Securities Division is a balance sheet dated September 30, 2005 and that the most recent Form ADV filed with the IARD was filed on September 14, 2005.

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On January 11, 2008, the Securities Division sent a memorandum to all investment advisers registered in the State of Washington with a fiscal year end in December reminding them of the requirement to submit a fiscal year-end balance sheet prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

VIII.

On August 13, 2008, the Securities Division sent an e-mail message to Stephan John Miskjian at Stat indicating that the last updated Form ADV filed with the IARD was filed on September 14, 2005 and that an annual updated Form ADV must be filed on IARD within 90 days of the end of its fiscal year.

IX.

On October 6, 2008, the Securities Division sent an e-mail message to Stat reminding Stat that the Division had not yet received a balance sheet for its last fiscal year end as required by WAC 460-24A-060 and asking for confirmation that Stat had filed an updated Form ADV with IARD. That message indicated that the attempts of the Securities Division to contact Stat regarding these issues have been unsuccessful and that failure to submit the required items may result in a referral to the exams and/or enforcement units for review.

X.

On October 13, 2008 at approximately 2:18 p.m., Faith Anderson, a financial legal examiner with the Securities Division, called Stat to speak to Stephan John Miskjian concerning the need to file a balance sheet dated December 31, 2007. Faith Anderson left a voicemail message that the Securities Division intended to revoke the registration of Stat if we did not receive a balance sheet dated December 31, 2007 by the close of business the next day.

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As of the date of this order, Stat has not submitted a balance sheet for the year ended December 31, 2007 or any later period and has not filed an update to its Form ADV on IARD since September 14, 2005.

XII.

The Securities Administrator finds that the continued registration of Stat as an investment adviser as described in the above Tentative Findings of Fact presents a threat to the investing public.

Based upon the above Tentative Findings of Fact, the following Conclusions of Law are made:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.

Stat has willfully violated WAC 460-24A-060 because it has not filed a balance sheet prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles dated December 31, 2007 or later.

II.

Stat has willfully violated WAC 460-24A-205 because it has not filed an updated Form ADV with the IARD since September 14, 2005.

III.

The willful violations of WAC 460-24A-060 and 460-24A-205 constitute grounds for the entry of an order summarily revoking the registration of Stat as an investment adviser under RCW 21.20.110(1)(b).

IV.

The Securities Administrator finds that an emergency exists, that the continued violations of WAC 460-24A-060 and 460-24A-205, constitute a threat to the investing public, and that a summary order suspending registration is in the public interest and necessary for the protection of the investing public.

SUMMARY ORDER

Based on the foregoing, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY SUMMARILY ORDERED That the current investment adviser registration of Stat Investment Strategies, Corp. is suspended.

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The Division may continue its investigation of Respondent and its agents and affiliates and may take additional enforcement action under the Washington Securities Act as the investigation warrants.

AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE

This Order is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 21.20.110 and is subject to the provisions of Chapter 34.05 RCW. Stat Investment Strategies, Corp. may make a written request for a hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING accompanying this order.

If the Respondent does not timely request a hearing, the Securities Administrator intends to adopt the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as final and make the Summary Order Suspending Investment Adviser Registration permanent as to the Respondent.

WILLFUL VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.
