INTRODUCTION

On February 19, 2010, the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Washington issued a CORRECTED Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Enter Order to Cease and Desist (Order Number S-09-208-09-SC01), hereinafter referred to as the "Statement of Charges" against Garage Floor Coating Franchise System, Inc. and Robert Hanson. The Respondents hereby enter into this Consent Order in settlement of the above-captioned matter. The Securities Division made certain allegations and conclusions in the Statement of Charges, set forth under the headings "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law." The Respondents neither admit nor deny the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

CONSENT ORDER

Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest:

2 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Garage Floor Coating Franchise  
3 System, Inc. and Robert Hanson, and their agents and employees, each shall cease and desist  
4 from any violation of RCW 19.100.020, the registration requirement provision of the Franchise  
5 Investment Protection Act of the State of Washington.

8 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondents, Garage Floor Coating Franchise System,  
9 Inc. and Robert Hanson, shall reimburse the Securities Division \$625, payable prior to the entry  
10 of this Consent Order, for its costs of investigation of this matter.

12 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this  
13 Consent Order.

15 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Garage Floor Coating Franchise  
16 System, Inc. shall inform the current Washington franchisees of this Consent Order by  
17 providing that franchisee a copy of this Consent Order. Garage Floor Coating Franchise  
18 System, Inc. shall provide to the Securities Division within 60 days of the date of entry of this  
19 Consent Order proof of receipt or proof of delivery to those franchisees of a copy of this  
20 Consent Order.


