INTRODUCTION

On June 15, 2010, the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington issued Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Enter Order to Cease and Desist S-10-233-10-SC-01, hereinafter referred to as “Statement of Charges,” against Respondents World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League, Inc.; A. J. Wiley; Shane McCullough; and Kurt McPhail. The Securities Division and Respondents World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League, Inc.; A. J. Wiley; Shane McCullough; and Kurt McPhail do hereby enter into this Consent Order in settlement of the matters alleged herein. The Securities Division has, in the Statement of Charges, made certain allegations and conclusions, set forth under the headings “Tentative Findings of Fact” and “Conclusions of Law.” The Respondents neither admit nor deny the Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

1 **CONSENT ORDER**

2 Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest:

3 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents World Poker Tour Amateur Poker
4 League, Inc.; A. J. Wiley; Shane McCullough; and Kurt McPhail, their agents and employees
5 each shall cease and desist from offering or selling franchises in violation of RCW 19.100.020,
6 the registration section of the Franchise Investment Protection Act.

7
8 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents World Poker Tour
9 Amateur Poker League, Inc.; A. J. Wiley; Shane McCullough; and Kurt McPhail, their agents
10 and employees each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 19.100.080, the offering
11 circular provision of the Franchise Investment Protection Act.

12 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondent World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League,
13 Inc. shall reimburse the Securities Division \$500, payable prior to the entry of this Consent
14 Order, for its costs of investigation of this matter.

15 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondents World Poker Tour Amateur Poker
16 League, Inc.; A. J. Wiley; Shane McCullough; and Kurt McPhail enter into this Consent Order
17 freely and voluntarily and with a full understanding of its terms and significance.

18 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this
19 Order.


