STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Please take notice that the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington has reason to believe that Respondents World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League, Inc., A. J. Wiley, Shane McCullough, and Kurt McPhail have each violated the Franchise Investment Protection Act of Washington, RCW 19.100, and that their violations justify the entry of an order of the Securities Administrator under RCW 19.100.248 against each to cease and desist from such violations.

The Securities Administrator finds as follows:

TENTATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

PARTIES

1. World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League, Inc. is a Kansas corporation with its principal place of business at 900 George Washington Blvd, Wichita, KS 67211.

2 **NOTICE OF INTENT TO ORDER THE RESPONDENT TO CEASE AND DESIST**

3 Based on the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Securities
4 Administrator intends to order that World Poker Tour Amateur Poker League, Inc., their agents,
5 and employees each shall cease and desist from violations of RCW 19.100.020 and RCW
6 19.100.080.

8 **AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE**

9 This Order is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 19.100.248 and RCW
10 19.100.130 and is subject to the provisions of RCW 34.05. World Poker Tour Amateur Poker
11 League, Inc., A. J. Wiley, Shane McCullough, and Kurt McPhail may each make a written
12 request for a hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND
13 OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING accompanying this order.

14 If a respondent does not request a hearing, the Securities Administrator intends to adopt
15 the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as final and enter a permanent
16 order to cease and desist as to that respondent.
