On May 17, 2012, the Securities Administrator of the state of Washington entered a Statement of Charges, S-11-0814-12-SC01, against Respondents Vend-A-Future of Seattle, Ltd., Jason Nelson, and Tracy Coats.

The Securities Division and Tracy Coats do hereby enter into this Consent Order in settlement of the matters above-captioned matter. The Securities Division made certain allegations and conclusions in the Statement of Charges, set forth under the headings "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law." Respondent Tracy Coats neither admits nor denies the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Statement of Charges, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

CONSENT ORDER

Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest:

IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Tracy Coats, his agents and employees each shall cease and desist from offering or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW 19.110.050, the registration section of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the state of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Tracy Coats, his agents and employees each shall cease and desist from offering or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW 19.110.070, the disclosure document section of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the state of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Tracy Coats, his agents and employees each shall cease and desist from offering or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW 19.110.120, the unlawful acts section of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the state of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondent Tracy Coats shall reimburse the Securities Division \$1,000 for its costs of investigation payable prior to the Securities Division's entry of this Consent Order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this Order.
