Pursuant to the Securities Act of Washington, ch. 21.20 RCW, the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions (“Securities Division”) and Respondents, Clement Ireo Ejedawe (“Ejedawe”) and Bradford Capital Group, Inc., do hereby enter into this CONSENT ORDER in settlement of the matters alleged herein. Respondents neither admit nor deny the Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in Statement of Charges and Notice of Intention to Enter Order to Cease and Desist (“Statement of Charges”), Order #SDO-02-00, and which are incorporated by reference into this Consent Order. However, as a condition for the entry of this Consent Order, each Respondent hereby represents to the Securities Division that they have not offered or sold any investments in the State of Washington, except to the two Washington investors who are referred to in the Statement of Charges.

1 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Clement Ireo Ejedawe and Bradford Capital  
2 Group, Inc., and their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from offering or selling securities  
3 in violation of RCW 21.20.140, the securities registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Clement Ireo Ejedawe and  
5 Bradford Capital Group, Inc., and their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from acting as  
6 an unregistered securities broker-dealer or salesperson in violation of RCW 21.20.040, the broker-dealer  
7 and securities salesperson registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

8 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Clement Ireo Ejedawe and  
9 Bradford Capital Group, Inc., and their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from violating  
10 RCW 21.20.010, the anti-fraud section of the Securities Act of Washington.

11 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED THAT Respondents, Clement Ireo Ejedawe and  
12 Bradford Capital Group, Inc., each shall pay \$500 for the costs of investigating this matter.

13 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this order.

14 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in consideration of the foregoing, Respondents, Clement Ireo  
15 Ejedawe and Bradford Capital Group, Inc., each waive their rights to a hearing in this matter and to  
16 judicial review of this order.

18 The Securities Division hereby vacates the Statement of Charges, Order #SDO-02-00, except to the  
19 extent that the findings and conclusions in that Statement of Charges have been incorporated herein.
