The Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions, pursuant to the Securities Act of Washington, and Respondent, JEANNE A. PERKINS do hereby enter into this CONSENT ORDER in settlement of the above captioned matter and JEANNE A. PERKINS hereby consents to the entry of this CONSENT ORDER. The Securities Division has, in SDO-099-01, made certain tentative findings and conclusions in SDO-099-01, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

**CONSENT ORDER**

The Securities Division and Respondent, JEANNE A. PERKINS have agreed upon a basis for resolution of the matters alleged and concluded in SDO-099-01 and JEANNE A. PERKINS agrees to the entry of this Consent Order pursuant to the Securities Act of Washington without admitting or denying the Securities Division's tentative findings and conclusions.

Based upon the foregoing:

IT IS AGREED that the Securities Administrator has the authority to enter this Consent Order and has jurisdiction over the subject matter therein.

1 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that JEANNE A. PERKINS shall not violate RCW  
2 21.20.110(1)(g), that section of the Washington State Securities Act dealing with dishonest and unethical  
3 practices in the securities business.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that JEANNE A. PERKINS shall reimburse the Securities Division for  
5 investigatory costs incurred in this matter in the amount of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars. Such  
6 reimbursement shall be paid in full prior to entry of this Consent Order.

7 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that, in consideration for compliance with its terms, the Securities  
8 Division shall not report this Consent Order, EXCEPT that if JEANNE A. PERKINS commits a violation  
9 of the Securities Act of Washington at any time within two years of the entry date of this Consent Order,  
10 the Securities Division may report this Consent Order on the Central Registration Depository and take  
11 such further action against JEANNE A. PERKINS it deems necessary.

13 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that JEANNE A. PERKINS waives any rights she may have to a hearing  
14 on or judicial review of this matter.
