The Securities Division, Department of Financial Institutions, State of Washington, and Respondent, Liberty Vending, Co., do hereby agree to this Consent Order in settlement of the above captioned matter. The Securities Division has, in SDO-22-01, made certain allegations and conclusions, set forth under the headings "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law" which are hereby incorporated by reference into this consent order. Respondents neither admit nor deny the "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law" as set forth in SDO-22-01.

ORDER AND CONSENT

Based upon the foregoing,

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED That Respondents Liberty Vending, Co., and its agents and employees, shall cease and desist from offering and/or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW 19.110.070 and RCW 19.110.120, the disclosure document and antifraud provisions of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act, respectively.

1 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Liberty Vending, Co., and its agents
2 and employees, shall cease and desist from offering and/or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW
3 19.110.050(1), the registration requirement provision of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act.

4 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Liberty Vending, Co., shall disclose
5 the existence and contents of this Order, as well as any other action required to be disclosed pursuant to RCW
6 19.110.070, in any business opportunity registration disclosure document approved for use in the state of
7 Washington, such requirement commencing from the date of entry of this Order.

8 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that Respondent Liberty Vending, Co., shall reimburse the Securities
9 Division \$1000 for its costs of investigation of this matter, payable prior to the date of entry of this Order.

10 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that Respondent Liberty Vending, Co. waives its right to a hearing in
11 this matter.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Summary Order to Cease and Desist SDO-22-01 is hereby
13 vacated.
