



1 Based upon the foregoing, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Roger A. Chinn  
2 and E. Arlene Chinn shall each cease and desist from offering and selling securities in any manner in violation of  
3 RCW 21.20.140, the securities registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn shall each cease  
5 and desist from acting as an unregistered securities broker-dealer or salesperson in violation of RCW 21.20.040,  
6 the broker-dealer and securities salesperson registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

7 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn shall each cease  
8 and desist from offering and selling securities in any manner in violation of RCW 21.20.010, the anti-fraud  
9 provisions of the Securities Act of Washington.

10 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that E. Arlene Chinn shall cease and desist from making, or  
11 causing to be made, misleading filings with the Securities Division in violation of RCW 21.20.350, the section of  
12 the Securities Act of Washington prohibiting misleading filings.

13 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Roger A. Chinn, E. Arlene Chinn, or any entity  
14 controlled by Roger A. Chinn or E. Arlene Chinn will not claim or rely on the exemptions from registration under  
15 RCW 21.20.320(1), (9), (11), (13), or (17) for a period of three (3) years from the date of entry of this CONSENT  
16 ORDER unless that Roger A. Chinn, E. Arlene Chinn, or any entity controlled by Roger A. Chinn or E. Arlene  
17 Chinn obtain express prior written permission from the Securities Administrator.

18 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn shall not participate in any manner in  
19 the offer, sale, or the effecting or attempt to effect the offer or sale of or any transaction in any securities issued  
20 by, through, or for the benefit of BMD Enterprises, Ltd. and its subsidiaries, Northwest Eagle, Inc., Reliant of  
21 America, Inc., Northwest Reliant, Inc., and any successor(s) or assign(s) thereof for a period of three (3) years  
22 from the date of entry of this CONSENT ORDER, except that Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn may offer to  
23 sell, sell, offer to purchase, or purchase said securities in the secondary market for their own account; Provided,  
24 however, that such offer, sale, or purchase is made in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

1 IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn each withdraw their

3 vacates the STATEMENT OF CHARGES AND NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ENTER ORDER TO CEASE  
4 AND DESIST SDO 42 – 99 as to Roger A. Chinn and E. Arlene Chinn except to the extent that the allegations  
5 and conclusions in that STATEMENT OF CHARGES have been incorporated herein.
