FINAL ORDER

I. <u>DIRECTOR'S CONSIDERATION</u>

A. <u>Procedural History</u> . This matter has come before the Director of the
Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Washington (Director) pursuant to RCW
34.05.464. On July 18, 2007, the Director, through his designee, Consumer Services Division Director
Deborah Bortner, entered a Statement of Charges and Notice of Intention to Enter an Order to Deny
License Application (Statement of Charges). A copy of the Statement of Charges is attached and
incorporated into this order by this reference. The Statement of Charges was accompanied by a cover
letter dated July 19, 2007, a Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, and blank
Applications for Adjudicative Hearing. The Department served the Statement of Charges, cover letter,
Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, and blank Applications for
Adjudicative Hearing on Respondent on July 20, 2007 by Federal Express overnight delivery.
On July 26, 2007, Respondent filed an Application for Adjudicative Hearing. On July 30,
2007, the Department made a request to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) to assign an

Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to schedule and conduct a hearing on the Statement of Charges. On August 9, 2007, OAH issued a Notice of Assignment of Administrative Law Judge assigning ALJ Michael W. Furtado (ALJ Furtado) to preside over prehearing and hearing proceedings and issue an

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II. FINAL ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, and the Director having considered the record and being otherwise fully advised, NOW, THEREFORE:

A. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That:

- 1. Respondent Jaffray's application for a license to conduct the business of a loan originator is denied.
- B. Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, Respondents have the right to file a Petition for Reconsideration stating the specific grounds upon which relief is requested. The Petition must be filed in the Office of the Director of the Department of Financial Institutions by courier at 150 Israel Road SW, Turnwater, Washington 98501, or by U.S. Mail at P.O. Box 41200, Olympia, Washington 98504-1200, within ten (10) days of service of the Final Order upon Respondents. The Petition for Reconsideration shall not stay the effectiveness of this order nor is a Petition for Reconsideration a prerequisite for seeking judicial review in this matter.

A timely Petition for Reconsideration is deemed denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on a petition.

- C. <u>Stay of Order</u>. The Director has determined not to consider a Petition to Stay the effectiveness of this order. Any such requests should be made in connection with a Petition for Judicial Review made under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.
- D. <u>Judicial Review</u>. Respondents have the right to petition the superior court for judicial review of this agency action under the provisions of chapter 34.05 RCW. For the requirements for filing a Petition for Judicial Review, see RCW 34.05.510 and sections following.

F. <u>Service.</u> For purposes of filing a Petition for Reconsideration or a Petition for Judicial Review, service is effective upon deposit of this order in the U.S. mail, declaration of service attached hereto.
