## I. DIRECTOR'S CONSIDERATION

Respondent.

A. <u>Default</u> . This matter has come before the Director of the Department of				
Financial Institutions of the State of Washington (Director), through his designee, Consumer Services				
Division Director Deborah Bortner, pursuant to RCW 34.05.440(1). On December 20, 2007, the				
Director, through Consumer Services Division Director Deborah Bortner, entered a Statement of				
Charges and Notice of Intention to Enter an Order to Deny License Application (Statement of				
Charges). A copy of the Statement of Charges is attached and incorporated into this order by this				
reference. The Statement of Charges was accompanied by a cover letter dated December 20, 2007, a				
Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, and a blank Application for				
Adjudicative Hearing. The Department served the Statement of Charges, cover letter dated December				
20, 2007, Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, and blank Application for				
Adjudicative Hearing on Respondent on December 20, 2007, by first class mail and Federal Express				
overnight delivery. On December 22, 2007, the documents sent via Federal Express overnight				
delivery were delivered. The documents sent via first class mail were not returned to the Department				
by the United States Postal Service as undeliverable.				

Respondent did not request an adjudicative hearing within twenty calendar days after the Department served him with the Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, as provided for in WAC 208-08-050(2).

- B. <u>Record Presented</u>. The record presented to the Director's designee for her review and for entry of a final decision included the Statement of Charges, cover letter dated December 20, 2007, Notice of Opportunity to Defend and Opportunity for Hearing, and blank Application for Adjudicative Hearing, with documentation of service.
- C. <u>Factual Findings and Grounds For Order</u>. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.440(1), the Director's designee hereby adopts the Statement of Charges, which is attached hereto.

#### II. FINAL ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, and the Director's designee having considered the record and being otherwise fully advised, NOW, THEREFORE:

- A. <u>IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</u>, that Respondent Charles Roger Methvin's application for a loan originator license is denied.
- B. Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, Respondent has the right to file a Petition for Reconsideration stating the specific grounds upon which relief is requested. The Petition must be filed in the Office of the Director of the Department of Financial Institutions by courier at 150 Israel Road SW, Tumwater, Washington 98501, or by U.S. Mail at P.O. Box 41200, Olympia, Washington 98504-1200, within ten (10) days of service of the Final Order upon Respondent. The Petition for Reconsideration shall not stay the effectiveness of this order nor is a Petition for Reconsideration a prerequisite for seeking judicial review in this matter.

A timely Petition for Reconsideration is deemed denied if, within twenty (20) days from the date the petition is filed, the agency does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on a petition.

- C. <u>Stay of Order.</u> The Director's designee has determined not to consider a Petition to Stay the effectiveness of this order. Any such requests should be made in connection with a Petition for Judicial Review made under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.
- D. <u>Judicial Review</u>. Respondent has the right to petition the superior court for judicial review of this agency action under the provisions of chapter 34.05 RCW. For the requirements for filing a Petition for Judicial Review, see RCW 34.05.510 and sections following.
- E. <u>Service</u>. For purposes of filing a Petition for Reconsideration or a Petition for Judicial Review, service is effective upon deposit of this order in the U.S. mail, declaration of service attached hereto.

#### INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to RCW 19.146.220 and RCW 19.146.223, the Director of the Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Washington (Director) is responsible for the administration of chapter 19.146 RCW, the Mortgage Broker Practices Act (Act)<sup>1</sup>. After having conducted an investigation pursuant to RCW 19.146.310, and based upon the facts available as of the date of this Statement of Charges, the Director, through his designee, Division of Consumer Services Director Deborah Bortner, institutes this proceeding and finds as follows:

#### I. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

- Respondent Charles Roger Methvin (Respondent Methvin) submitted an application to the 1.1 Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Washington (Department) for a loan originator license under National Lending Corp., a mortgage broker licensed under the Act. The on-line application was received by the Department on or about December 30, 2007.
- Outstanding Liens and Judgments. On or about May 3, 2005, the U.S. Department of Treasury filed 1.2 a tax lien against Respondent Methvin with the Clark County, Washington, Auditor in the amount of \$72,387. On or about June 24, 2005, the U.S. Department of Treasury filed a second tax lien against Respondent Methvin with the Clark County, Washington, Auditor in the amount of \$116,195. These tax liens do not appear to be paid or otherwise resolved.
