AGREEMENT AND ORDER

Pursuant to chapter 18.44 RCW, the Escrow Agent Registration Act (Act) and RCW 34.05.060 of the Administrative Procedure Act, Respondents hereby agree to the Department's entry of this Consent Order and further agree that the issues raised in the above-captioned matter may be economically and efficiently settled by entry of this Consent Order. wrongdoing by its entry. Respondents are agreeing not to contest the Statement of Charges in consideration of the terms of this Consent Order.

Based upon the foregoing:

- A. **Jurisdiction**. It is AGREED that the Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the activities discussed herein.
- B. Waiver of Hearing. It is AGREED that Respondents have been informed of the right to a hearing before an administrative law judge, and that they hereby waived their right to a hearing and any and all administrative and judicial review of the issues raised in this matter, or of the resolution reached herein.

 Accordingly, Respondents agree to withdraw their appeal and to inform the Office of Administrative Hearings in writing of their withdrawal.
- C. No Admission of Liability. The parties intend this Consent Order to fully resolve the Statement of Charges and agree that Respondents do not admit to any wrongdoing by its entry.
- D. Agreements. It is AGREED that Respondents understand the necessity to obtain and maintain a license and to properly disburse monies according to a transaction's escrow instructions.
- E. Fine. It is AGREED that Respondents shall pay to the Department a fine of \$7.500, in the form of a cashier's check made payable to the "Washington State Treasurer," upon entry of this Consent Order.
- F. Restitution. It is AGREED that Respondents shall refund \$1,500 to the seller referenced in paragraph D above, upon entry of this Consent Order.
- G. Investigation Fee. It is AGREED that Respondents shall pay to the Department an investigation fee of \$1,875, in the form of a cashier's check made payable to the "Washington State Treasurer," upon entry of this Consent Order. The fine and investigation fee may be paid in one cashier's check..
- H. Authority to Execute Order. It is AGREED that the undersigned Respondents have represented and warranted that they have the full power and right to execute this Consent Order on behalf of the parties represented.

STATEMENT OF CHARGES and NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE OR SUSPEND ESCROW AGENT AND DESIGNATED ESCROW OFFICER LICENSE, PROHIBIT FROM INDUSTRY, IMPOSE FINE, AND COLLECT INVESTIGATION FEE

INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to RCW 18.44.410, the Director of the Department of Financial Institutions (Director) is responsible for the administration of chapter 18.44 RCW, the Escrow Agent Registration Act (the Act). After having conducted an investigation pursuant to RCW 18.44.420 and WAC 208-680G-020, and based upon the facts available as of the date of this Statement of Charges, the Director, through his designee Division of Consumer Services Director Deborah Bortner, institutes this proceeding and finds as follows:

I. FACTUAL ALLEGATIONS

1.1 Respondents.

A. Approved Escrow Inc (Respondent Approved Escrow) was licensed by the Department to conduct the business of an escrow agent on March 8, 2009, and continues to be licensed to date. Respondent Approved Escrow was licensed to conduct business from one location: 16204 Pacific Ave, Suite 4, Spanaway, Washington, 98387.

- В. Todd Charles Kennedy (Respondent Kennedy) is 100% Owner and President of Respondent Approved Escrow.
- C. Debbie Darlene Parker (Respondent Parker) applied for an Escrow Officer license with the Department on or about December 30, 2008. Respondent Parker was licensed as Designated Escrow Officer (DEO) for Respondent Approved Escrow on March 8, 2009, and continues to be licensed to date.
- Unlicensed Activity. Between at least May 30, 2008, and March 7, 2009, Respondents 1.2 provided escrow services in at least 113 Washington real estate transactions. Respondents received fees totaling \$92,333.80 for these escrow services. Respondents did not have an Escrow Agent, Designated Escrow Officer, or Escrow Officer license during the time in question.
- 1.3 **On-Going Investigation.** The Department's investigation into the alleged violations of the Act by Respondents continues to date.

II. GROUNDS FOR ENTRY OF ORDER

- 2.1 **Prohibition Against Unlicensed Activity.** Based on the factual allegations set forth in Section I above, Respondents are in apparent violation of RCW 18.44.021, RCW 18.44.071, RCW 18.44.101, and RCW 18.44.171 for conducting escrow transactions without a license or designated escrow officer.
- 2.2 **Prohibited Practices.** Based on the factual allegations set forth in Section I above, Respondents are in apparent violation of RCW 18.44.301(1), (2) and (4) for directly or indirectly employing any scheme, device, or artifice to defraud or mislead borrowers or lenders or to defraud any person or directly or indirectly engaging in any unfair or deceptive practice toward any person or knowingly making, publishing or disseminating any false, deceptive, or misleading information in the conduct of the business of escrow, or relative to the business of escrow or relative to any person engaged therein.

III. AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE SANCTIONS

- 3.1 Authority to Revoke or Suspend License. Pursuant to RCW 18.44.430(1)(b), the Director may revoke the license of any escrow officer for violating any of the provisions of the Act or any lawful rules made by the Director pursuant to the Act.
- 3.2 Authority to Prohibit from the Industry. Pursuant to RCW 18.44.430(3), in addition to or in lieu of suspension, revocation, or license denial the Director may remove and/or prohibit from participation in the conduct of the affairs of a licensed escrow agent, any officer, controlling person, director, employee, or licensed escrow officer.
- **3.3** Authority to Impose Fine. Pursuant to RCW 18.44.430(3) and WAC 208-680G-040(3), in addition to or in lieu of suspension, revocation, or license denial the Director may impose a fine of up to \$100 per day for each day's violation of the Act or rules adopted thereunder.
- **3.4** Authority to Collect Investigation Fees. Pursuant to RCW 18.44.410 and WAC 208-680G-050, the expense of an investigation pursuant to WAC 208-680G-020 shall be borne by the entity which is the subject of the investigation.

IV. NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ENTER ORDER

Respondents' violations of the provisions of chapter 18.44 RCW as set forth in the above Factual Allegations, Grounds For Entry Of Order, and Authority to Impose Sanctions constitute a basis for the entry of an Order under RCW 18.44.410, RCW 18.44.430, RCW 18.44.301, and WAC 208-680G-030, which authorize the Director to enforce all laws, rules, and regulations related to the registration of escrow agents and licensing of escrow officers. Therefore, it is the Director's intention to ORDER that:

- **4.1** Respondent Approved Escrow Inc's license to conduct the business of an escrow agent be revoked or suspended;
- 4.2 Respondent Debbie Darlene Parker's designated escrow officer license be revoked or suspended;

V. AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE

This Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Revoke or Suspend Escrow Agent and Designated Escrow Officer License, Prohibit from Industry, Impose Fine, and Collect Investigation Fee (Statement of Charges) is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 18.44.410 and RCW 18.44.430, and is subject to the provisions of chapter 34.05 RCW. Respondents may make a written request for a hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING accompanying this Statement of Charges.
