3 following terms:


4 **Factual Basis for Judgment**

6 Van Hook have agreed upon a basis for resolution of the matters alleged in Statement of Charges
7 No. C-07-487-07-SC02 (Amended Statement of Charges), entered July 22, 2008. Matthew
8 Wendell Van Hook has agreed to enter into a Confession of Judgment, pursuant to chapter 4.60
9 RCW, in the amount of \$45,843.48, of which he shall pay \$25,000 to the Department of
10 Financial Institutions for a fine, \$4,560.00 to the Department of Financial Institutions for the
11 cost of investigation, \$10,000.00 to Rhona Villanueva, and \$6,283.48 to Willie Earthman.




13 I, Matthew Wendell Van Hook, being duly sworn upon oath, acknowledge my debt of


